Club Championships get underway, Braeden Klaty engineers 1st Upset

With three rounds completed in the 2023 PHCC club championships barely begun, **Braeden Klaty** capped a snowy evening by thrashing **Lon Rutkofske** in a lengthy 69 move contest as a lack of stamina raised its ugly head spelling doom for the club tournament director blundered a critical f-pawn in what appeared to be a dead-drawn ending. Playing the Black pieces, Lon responded to the Sanilac sensation's 1.e4, Nc3 with a surprising Petroff defense, an opening he had never previously used. It appeared that this took Braeden by surprise because it caused him to think long and hard on an appropriate response. From there play followed book lines through move 12 as Lon equalized it what ended up in an extended positional struggle, with each side trying to secure even a small advantage. The ending proved to be a frustrating affair for Lon, as even after he blundered the crucial pawn the end of the game proved to be an interesting time scramble with the senior member have over 8 minutes remaining to his junior adversary's 24 seconds. As it turned out, the time issue proved moot after move 69.hg5+ ended the contest immediately. In other third round games of note, **Bill Wingrove** managed a strong showing against a tactical whiz, **Ryan Urick's** French Defenses to secure a well-earned draw.

What seems most remarkable in this year's competition has to the turnout featuring 13 USCF rated participants for the first time in over a decade. The addition of two new USCF members, **Sandi Fisher** and **Ryan Urick** are both seeking their initial US Chess ratings, and are novices are attacking the event at full-throttle as they earn their spurs through the rigors of Championship play. Results and games are available after each round on the PHCC website, as well as in monthly publications of <u>Chess Chatter</u>.

It has been suggested that to reduce that time frame for the annual championships that the contest be broken down into two sections, a Closed Section composed of the players with USCF ratings over 1700, and a Reserve Section with ratings of 1700 and below. This would probably mean a format that might call for dual round robin events, with the winner of the Reserve section automatically eligible for the Closed section for the following year's championships. Some feedback on this suggestion would be greatly appreciated at the end of this year's competition.

[This a reminder of the change in policy in the PHCC Challenge rules: # 14 - Games can be rated by the USCF, provided both players are members in good standing with the USCF and agree to have it rated by paying in advance to the TD (Lon Rutkofske, or other club official with a valid TD certification card.) of \$1.50@ to cover rating costs.] Updated Challenge rules will follow below:

Format and rules for PHCC Challenge System

- I. Purpose: to provide club members the opportunity to challenge higher rated players on a regular basis to improve and test their skills in over the board non-tournament competition.
- II. Regulations: (Effective 11-8-2018)
 - a. Challenges may be made by any club member on the PHCC rating list under the following circumstances:
 - 1. Can only be made only by a lower rated player.
 - 2. Can only be made during club hours and cannot be made after 8:00PM.
 - 3. Must be played on the same day as the challenge was made, so there can be no advanced challenges.
 - 4. Both players must be present.
 - 5. Only one challenge may be made per meeting.
 - 6. Challenger can only challenge a player that is rated less than 400 points above him on the rating list.
 - 7. All challenges must be accepted.
 - 8. No challenge may be made while a participant is involved in a tournament or challenge game.
 - 9. A clock must be used with the time control of G/60 with 5 second delay; must be recorded by both players and submitted to the rating director upon completion of the game. (See Sample Score Sheet on page 2)
 - 10. All challenge games must comply with current tournament rules of chess as established by the US Chess Federation.
 - 11. No challenge game may be adjourned, but if an unusual circumstance arises, the club rating director may adjudicate.
 - 12. No member may be challenged more than one consecutive time by the same challenger. This means that the lower rated player cannot challenge the same player two times in a row. He/she must play another match before this can take place, but this also means that the higher rated player may be challenged by the same rated player consecutively if he has not participated in a match in between challenges within a six- week period. Abuse (I.E. Constant challenges and re-challenges or other annoying or inconsiderate behavior) must be reported to the Director and he has the option of suspending the violator indefinitely from participation in the Challenge system. Disputes will be adjudicated by the ratings director, with the advice of other players as he so wishes.
 - 13. Challenges can take place on the first Thursday of each month, or at any time there is no other tournament or event
 - 14. scheduled
 - 15. **Games can be rated by the USCF**, provided both players are members in good standing with the USCF and agree to have it rated by paying in advance to the TD (Lon Rutkofske, or other club official with a valid TD certification card.) of \$1.50@ to cover rating costs.
 - 16. Results will be rated by the PHCC (*Using the USCF rating system.*) using current PHCC ratings posted at the club and will be adjusted as necessary by the club rating director. Changes will also be posted on the club website.
